2019 Ohio Golf Association Hall of Fame inductees

Dr. Doug Hanzel — Born in Cleveland, Ohio in 1957, Hanzel found success in golf early and often, winning over 30 junior golf tournaments in the state of Ohio, including the 1974 Ohio High School State Championship. Hanzel attended Kent State University and served as team captain in 1978-1979. Hanzel's highlight of his golf career is winning the 2013 USGA Senior Amateur Championship at Wade Hampton Golf Club in Cashiers, N.C.

James C. "Skip" Snow — A native of Springfield, Ohio and a graduate of Miami University where he played on the basketball team from 1962-1965. Snow has won the Ohio Senior Amateur Championship three times and the Ohio Senior Amateur Super Senior division two times. Snow has been a perennial favorite in the Society of Seniors events where he has won three events. Snow was inducted in the Dayton Amateur Golf Hall of Fame in 2001.

Rod Spittle — During his collegiate golf career, Spittle helped Ohio State win the Big Ten Championship three consecutive years (1976-1978) alongside teammates John Cook and Joey Sindelar. Spittle won the Ohio Golf Association Mid Amateur Championship three times. In 2004 Spittle turned professional and played on the PGA Tour Champions. In 2010, Spittle won his first-ever professional title in a playoff over Jeff Sluman at the AT&T Championship. In 195 starts over his 13-year PGA Tour Champions career, Spittle missed just five cuts and earned more than \$4M in prize money.

- Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of meatal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Penalty for breach of this Local Rules: See Rule 4.3. Modern Local Rule G-7.
