

2020 Ohio Golf Association Hall of Fame Inductees

Robert Gerwin II — Gerwin has had an extremely successful Amateur career that includes participation in 35 USGA Championships, 5-time Greater Cincinnati Golf Association Champion, Ohio Mid-Amateur Champion, and two-time Ohio Amateur Champion. In 1996, Gerwin became the second person to win both the Ohio Amateur and Ohio Mid-Amateur in the same season! Gerwin currently holds four course records, including a 59 at Camargo Club during the Club Championship.

Thomas Grzywinski — A lifelong educator and mentor to young men and women. Grzywinski has been the caddie master a for the last 37 years with 30 of those years being at Sylvania Country Club. Over his 37 years, 105 of his caddies have earned the prestigious Evans Scholarship. Grzywinski is a member of five Hall of Fames, including the Toledo District Golf Association, where he was inducted in 2008.

Betty Kerby Peppard — Betty's life revolved around golf from an early age with her father, Ed Kerby being the Head Golf Professional at Fairlawn Country Club in Akron, Ohio. Throughout her career, Betty participated in five U.S. Women's Amateur Championships, won two Women's Ohio State Golf Association Amateur Championships, 13 Akron Women's District Golf Association Championships and was Low Amateur in four LPGA Tournaments. Betty accomplished what many dream of by achieving a perfect score on the USGA/PGA Rules of Golf Exam. Betty is a member of three Hall of Fames and in 2002 the WOSGA created the Betty Kerby Peppard award to recognize individuals that have made a significant impact on Women's Amateur golf in the state of Ohio.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Contestants shall apply on official OGA entry blank or online at www.ohiogolf.org. Entry fee refund available only for medical reasons after deadline date, July 24, 2020, 11:59 p.m. Late or incomplete applications not accepted. No telephone entries. On-line entry is available at WWW.OHIOGOLF.ORG. Must be (1) a male who has reached their 50th birthday on or before August 3, 2020.

ENTRY FEE: \$370—For those playing Sunday, Monday, Tuesday. Includes Golf, cart, and range all three days, lunch all three days, breakfast Monday & Tuesday, Cocktail party Sunday and Ceremony/Dinner on Monday.

ENTRY FEE: \$310—For those playing Monday and Tuesday only. Includes Golf, cart, and range Monday and Tuesday, lunch Monday and Tuesday, breakfast Monday & Tuesday, Ceremony/Dinner on Monday.

ENTRY FEE: \$85—For those playing on Sunday only. Sunday only participants are by invitation of the Ohio Golf Association and Plum Brook CC. These contestants do not need to be 50 years or older. If you are interested in playing on Sunday, please contact Ohio Golf Association. Includes, golf, cart, range, lunch, cocktail party and prizes on Sunday.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$55—Spouses, Guest and public are welcome to register based on availability to attend the Ohio Golf Association Hall of Fame Ceremony and Dinner on Monday evening. Includes Ceremony/Dinner on Monday only.

FORMAT: 36 hole stroke play (Monday & Tuesday).

Gross & Handicap prizes in three divisions.

Senior—50-64, Super Senior 65-69, Super Senior plus 70 & over.

Overall Champion will be determined by low gross score from any player who plays in the Senior or Super Senior divisions.

REGISTRATION: All players are required to register at Plum Brook CC on Sunday, August 2, 2020. You may pre-register by emailing or calling the OGA office. 614-698-0014. If you are not entering for Sunday, we will pre-register you.

CADDIES: A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round. Penalty for breach of Local Rule: The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which he or she is helped by such a caddie. If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. Modern Local Rule 8H.

SHOES: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with:

- Traditional spikes—that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic or other materials.

- Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Penalty for breach of this Local Rules: See Rule 4.3. Modern Local Rule G-7.
