

2021 Ohio Golf Association Hall of Fame Inductees

J. Stuart "Stu" Francis was born and raised in Madison, Ohio from 1952-1977. Francis lived a few years in New York City prior to residing in the San Francisco Bay area since 1980.

Francis is the current President of the United States Golf Association having been elected in 2020. Francis has served on the USGA Executive Committee since 2015 and chaired the USGA Championship Committee from 2016 thru 2019.

Rosie Jones an Ohio State golfer from 1978-1981 earned All-America honors in 1981 and won the 1980 individual Big Ten Championship. After her collegiate career, Jones had a storied professional career on the LPGA Tour. Jones played on the LPGA Tour from 1982 to 2006, winning 13 times with four runner-up finishes in major championships. Jones retired from the LPGA Tour in 2006 and launched her own golf travel company, Rosie Jones Golf Getaways. Jones is currently #27 on the LPGA all-time money list with over 8 million in earnings.

Meg Mallon an Ohio State golfer from 1982-1985 earning All-Conference honors in 1984 and 1985. Mallon was the runner-up at the 1985 Big Ten Championship. Mallon won the 1983 Michigan Women's Amateur Championship. Mallon joined the LPGA Tour in 1987 and had her breakthrough year in 1991, when she won four times. Two of her victories were majors. Mallon won the Mazda LPGA Championship and the USGA Women's Open that year. Mallon added two more major wins with her 2000 du Maurier Classic victory and her second USGA Women's Open victory in 2004. Mallon represented Team USA in the Solheim Cup eight times, was the assistant captain in 2009 and captained the team in 2013.

Mallon is a member of the World Golf Hall of Fame (2017), Ohio State Athletic Hall of Fame (1996), Michigan Golf Hall of Fame (2002), Michigan Sports Hall of Fame (2008) and the Palm Beach County Hall of Fame (2011). In 2000 Mallon was recognized by the LPGA Tour as one of the LPGA's top 50 players and teachers.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Contestants shall apply on official OGA entry blank or online at www.ohiogolf.org. Entry fee refund available only for medical reasons after deadline date, July 22, 2021, 11:59 p.m. Late or incomplete applications not accepted. No telephone entries. On-line entry is available at WWW.OHIOGOLF.ORG. Must be (1) a male who has reached their 50th birthday on or before August 2, 2021.

ENTRY FEE: \$370—For those playing Sunday, Monday, Tuesday. Includes Golf, cart, and range all three days, lunch all three days, breakfast Monday & Tuesday, Cocktail party Sunday and Ceremony/Dinner on Monday.

ENTRY FEE: \$310—For those playing Monday and Tuesday only. Includes Golf, cart, and range Monday and Tuesday, lunch Monday and Tuesday, breakfast Monday & Tuesday, Ceremony/Dinner on Monday.

ENTRY FEE: \$85—For those playing on Sunday only. Sunday only participants are by invitation of the Ohio Golf Association and Plum Brook CC. These contestants do not need to be 50 years or older. If you are interested in playing on Sunday, please contact Ohio Golf Association. Includes, golf, cart, range, lunch, cocktail party and prizes on Sunday.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$55--Spouses, Guests and public are welcome to register based on availability to attend the Ohio Golf Association Hall of Fame Ceremony and Dinner on Monday evening. Includes Ceremony/Dinner on Monday only.

Gross & Handicap prizes in three divisions.

Senior—50-64 (approx 6300 yards), Super Senior 65-69 (approx. 5800 yards), Super Senior plus 70 & over (approx. 5500 yards)

Overall Champion will be determined from the Senior division. Any player may choose to play in the senior division. .

REGISTRATION: All players are required to register at Plum Brook CC on Sunday, August 1, 2021. You may pre-register by emailing or calling the OGA office. 614-698-0014. If you are not entering for Sunday, we will pre-register you.

CADDIES: A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round. Penalty for breach of Local Rule: The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which he or she is helped by such a caddie. If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. Modern Local Rule 8H.

SHOES: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with:

- Traditional spikes—that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic or other materials.
- Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Penalty for breach of this Local Rules: See Rule 4.3. Modern Local Rule G-7.
